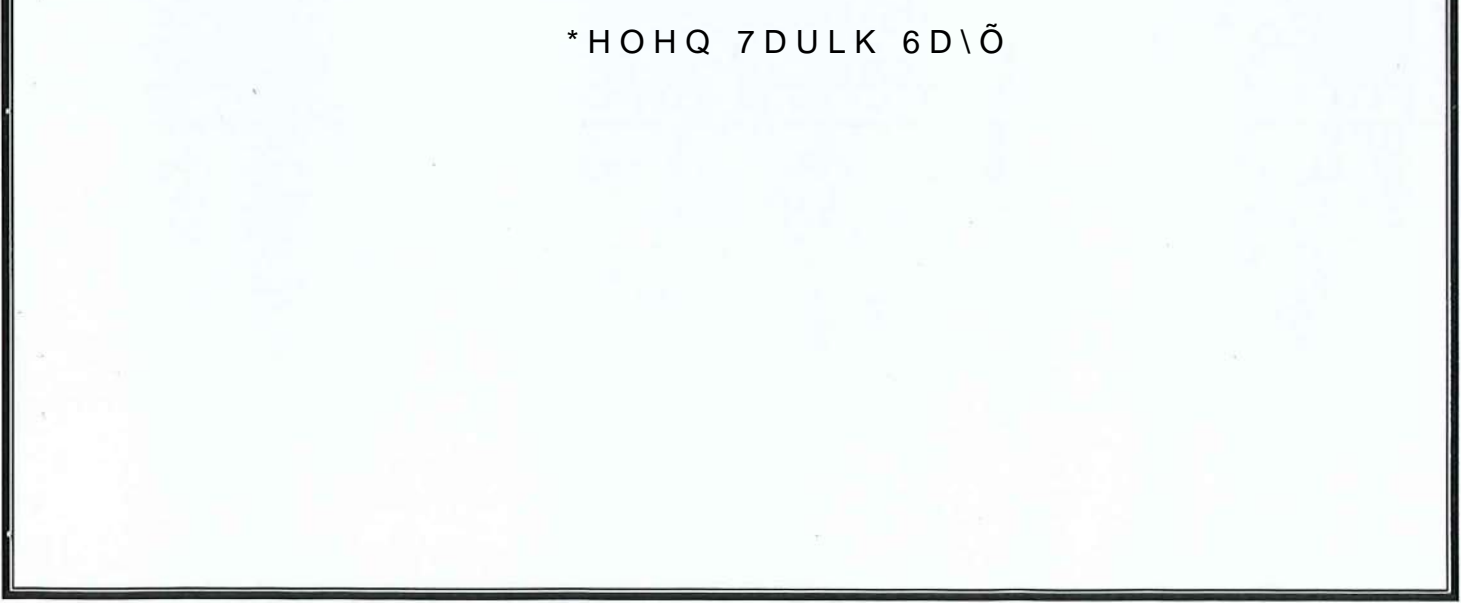

The **Ministry of Land Transport and Light Rail** is inviting bids from eligible bidders both local and international bidders through the Government eProcurement System for the **Construction of an Emergency Escape Ramp with a Vehicle Arrester System for runaway heavy good vehicles along Motorway M3, Valton.**

Bidders are advised to procure their DSC well before preparing the bids as it may take up to four days to obtain the DSC. 5. Bidders who have submitted proposals online by the closing date and time shall decrypt and re-encrypt their proposals as from **15.01 hours (Local Time) on Monday 15 April 2024 till 13 00 hours (Local Time) on Wednesday 17 April 2024.**
6. Proposals received will be opened online in the presence of the representatives of the bidders who choose to attend at the address below as from **13 01 hours (Local Time) on Wednesday 17 April 2024.**
